Pierre Peters Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs Brut NV (Champagne, France) 375ml/ 54  
100% Chardonnay from one of the region's top producers. Bright, sharp and focused with white peach, almond, brioche and a mineral tinged finished.

Geoffroy Rosé de Saignée 1er Cru Brut NV (Champagne, France) 375ml/ 58  
Rose petals, wild strawberries, raspberries, blackberries. Concentrated and well structured. 100% Pinot.

Jean-Baptist Adam Cremant d'Alsace NV (Alsace, France) 45  
Cremants are one of the best secrets in French sparkling. Full, bright, pure and refreshing with stone fruit, white flowers and and citrus.

Iron Horse Wedding Cuvee 2011 (Russian River Valley, California) 68  
Serious but fun. Dry and elegant with notes of peach, raspberry and blood orange. Cel-e-brate good times!

A. Margaine Brut Rose NV (Champagne, France) 95  
Smooth and expansive with juicy raspberry and tangerine notes. One of our favs at this years tasting.

Gaston Chiquet Brut Tradition NV (Champagne, France) 98  
Part of the 'grower' movement that is rocking the old guard of Champagne and winning consumers one sip at a time. Firm and dry with pineapple, fresh peach, ginger and almond.

H. Goutrobe Grand Cru Brut Rosé (Champagne, France) 120  
A dropp dead gorgeous wine! A silky and textured expression of Pinot Noir with a long, haunting finish.

Charles Heidsieck Brut Millesime 2005 (Champagne, France) 225  
Poised between elegance and complexity. Smooth and textured with great length. An exceptional vintage.

## INTERESTING WHITES

Dom Quilla, Muscadet 2013 Sevre et Maine (Loire, France) O 36  
Benchmark Muscadet from one of the Loire's most renown auteurs. A classic match with seafood and shellfish.

Cordero Langhe Arneis 2013 (Piedmonte, Italy) 40  
Named for the grape which it is made, Arneis means 'rascal' in Piedmontese. Crisp and racy with intense white peach notes, hazelnuts and acacia blossoms.

Wy'East Pinot Gris 2014 (Hood River, Oregon) 42  
One of the oldest plantings of Pinot Gris in the Northwest. Bright and vibrant peach and apricot over a crisp volcanic core.

Arndorfer 'Srasser Weinberge' Gruner Veltliner 2013 (Kamptal, Austria) O 48  
Crazy richness and texture for a gruner. A whisper of oak creates another dimension, softening Gruner's natural angles. As Martin Arndorfer says, 'This a wine that will make you happy'.

Classic Willamette from the folks who put it on the map. Elegant dried cherries with expressive floral notes.
- Michel Julliot Mercury 'Les Champs Martins' 1er Cru 2012 (Burgundy, France) 80  
Firm and structured with savory dark fruit and herbal underpinnings and a long contemplative finish.
- Brewer-Clifton Sta. Rita Hills 2013 (Sta. Rita Hills, California) 90  
Just put your nose in the glass and you will understand why Brewer-Clifton can't keep their wines in stock. Rich, graceful and fruit driven – showing vivid black cherries, anise and black licorice.
- Big Table Farm, Willamette Valley 2013 (Willamette Valley, Oregon) B 95  
This is a vibrant and energetic stunner packed with blackberry, dried cranberry, pomegranate, leather, oak, spice... Check out Duane the pig on the label. Tiny production, extremely limited!
- VML Stars 2012 (Russian River Valley, California) 106  
Virginia Marie Lambrix makes some of the most sumptuous and textured PN's in the RRV. Stars is rich and concentrated with layers of black cherry, ripe plum, violets, lavender, sandalwood and spice. Biodynamic.
- Rochioli Estate 2013 (Russian River Valley, California) 150  
Elegant and beautifully balanced with notes of ripe cherry, vanilla and savory herbs. Silky tannins and long finish.

- Domaine de Boissan Vacqueyras 2011 (Southern Rhone) 45  
A rich dark ruby blend of dark berries, cherry compote, licorice and allspice, cassis and bitter cherry. 80% Grenache, 20% Syrah.
- Olga Raffault 'Les Picasses', Chinon 100% Cabernet Franc 2007 (Loire, FR) O 54  
Won't you take me down...to funky town! Cocoa, licorice, rosemary, sage and smoke. Unmistakably Chinon, this is Cab Franc at its best.
- Georges Descomes Morgon 2014 (Beaujolais, France) O 56  
Artisan Gamay from a true master. Gorgeous aromas of raspberry and strawberry followed by more subtle notes of spice and fennel. Medium bodied with juicy red fruits.
- Dom. la Millière Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2012 (Rhone, France) O 125  
An absolutely gorgeous edition from this traditional estate. Classic aromas of black raspberry, licorice, lavender, and savory herbs with a long elegant finish.

- La Torre 'Ampelio' 2011 (Tuscany, Italy) 65  
This killer red blend is one of the best-kept secrets in Brunello. Medium-bodied and dry with dried cherries and layers of intense concentration. Sangiovese Grosso with Alicante and Cilieggiolo.
- Bel-Sit Barbera d'Asti Superiore Sichivej 2009 (Piedmont, Italy) 68  
Lush with seductive floral notes and chewy blackcherry, chocholate spice and tar. 500 cases made.
- Buglioni 'Il Bugiardo' Valpolicella Ripasso 2011 (Verona, Italy) 75  
Dark and concentrated enough that a group of Italian wine critics were so shocked that they were not drinking Amarone that they called it 'il Bugiardo' or 'liar'. The name stuck.
- De Foreville Barberesco 2011 (Piedmont, Italy) 80  
Velvety dark cherry fruit gives way layers truffle, rose petals, leather and tar. The 11' is singing right now!
- Cabutto Tenuta La Volta Barolo 2009 (Piedmont, Italy) 98  
Classically balanced dark cherry, rose petal and tar. You find a better Barolo for the money!
- Caprai Sagratino 2008 (Umbria, Italy) 120  
Picture the biggest, darkest, densist Napa Cab... Now imagine it was made in Italy. That's Sagratino. Please decant.
- Masi Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Serego Alighieri Vaio 2008 (Veneto, Italy) 150  
An elegant and imbecably balanced red, layering sculpted tannins finely knit black cherry, plum cured tobacco, Dark chocolate and woody spice. # 8 WS wine of the year!! Extremely limited.
- Il Poggione Brunello del Montalcino 2010 (Tuscany, Italy) 160  
Pure and concentrated offering loaded with ripe cherry, plum, spice, tobacco... full-bodied with soft integrated Tannin. A near perfect vintage from one of the region's best producers. A WS top 5 wine!!

- Chateau Musar, Jeune Rouge 2012 (Bekaa, Valley, Lebanon) 44  
A country with such beautiful history is bound to have some Smokin' (and smoky) wines. Cab, Syrah and Cinsault with a rich palate of red berries and a sprinkle of vanilla and cinnamon.
- Artadi 'Vinas de Gain' 2011 (Rioja, Spain) 48  
Textbook Rioja. 100% Tempranillo with notes of forest berries, black licorice and lightly toasted oak.
- Nita Priorat 2012 (Priorat, Spain) 54  
A rare gem! Old vine Garnacha and Carinena from the steep slate covered vineyards of Priorat. Totally unoaked.
- Peraj Peita 2013 (Montsant, Spain) 60  
60% Old Vine Grenache with a smattering of Tempranillo, Merlot and Syrah. Rich, bright and lively with surprising depth and nuance.
- Marco Abella 'Loidana' 2009 (Priorat, Spain) 72  
Grenache and Carrignan with a kiss of Cabernet. Black fruit and licorice that will warm you up on a cold night. The label by renowned Catalan abstract painter Josep Guinovart speaks to the regions rich history.
- Tinto Pesquera Crianza, Tempranillo 2012 (Ribera del Duero, Spain) 78  
When Alejandro Fernandez first released his seductive wines in the early 1970's they were a game changer, today they are an institution. Midweight with black cherries, dark berries, sandalwood, scorched earth and smoke.
